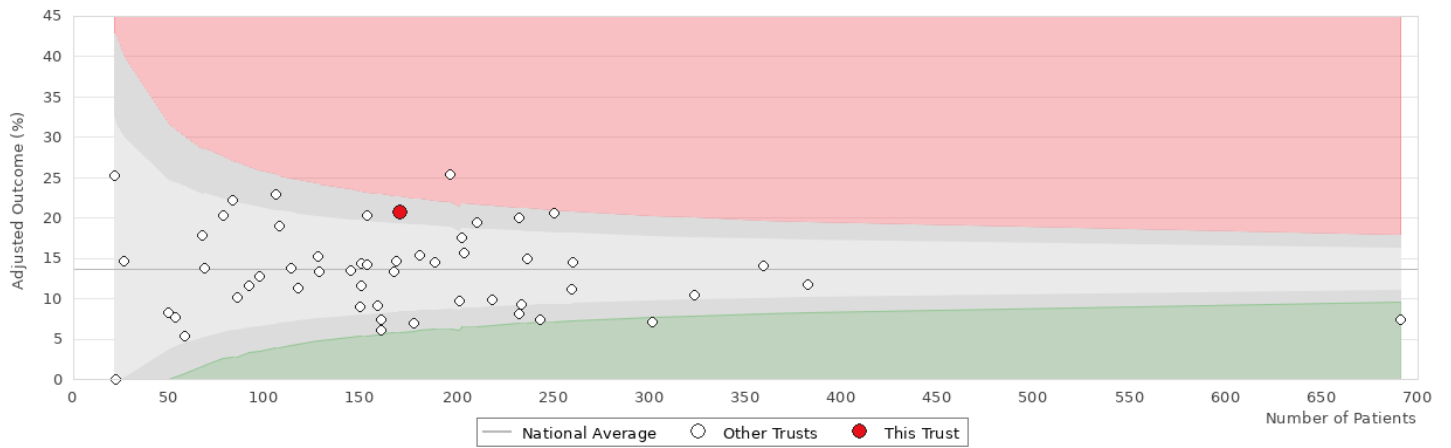

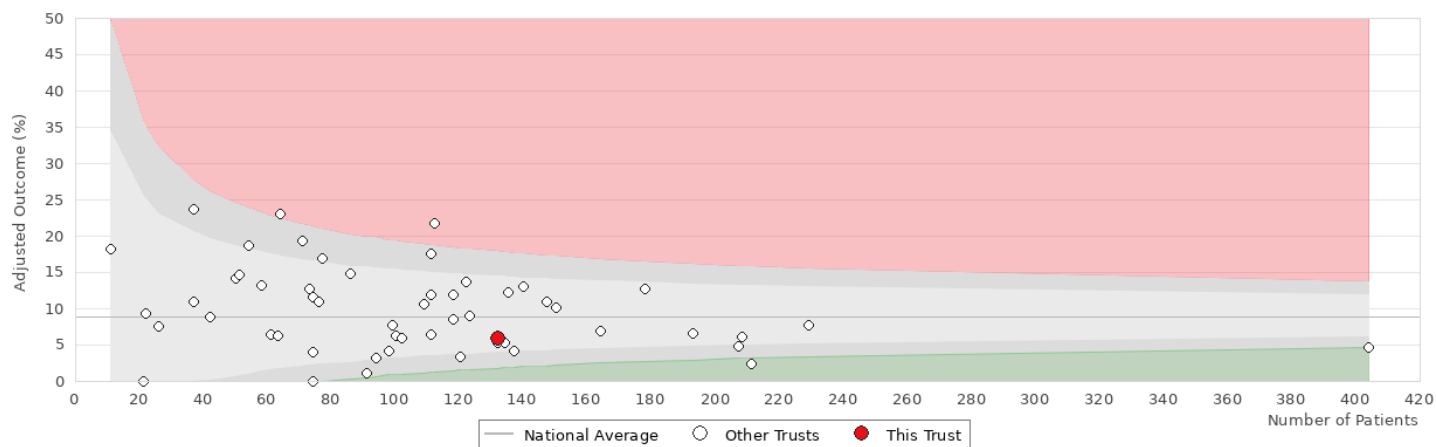

## Adjusted funnel plot for the proportion of patients readmitted as an emergency within 90 days of radical prostatectomy by surgical centre in England and Wales.



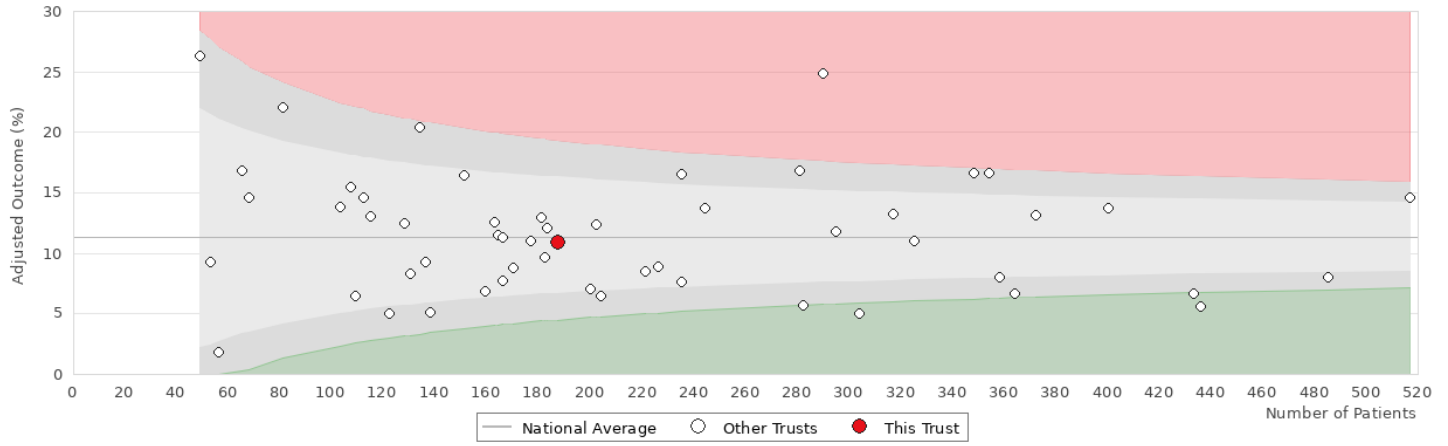

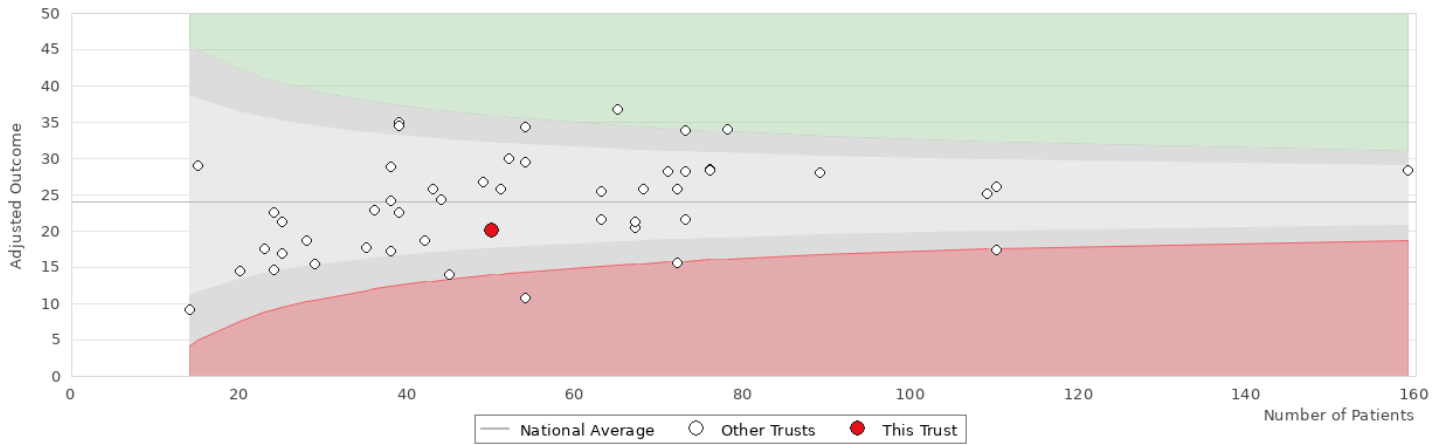

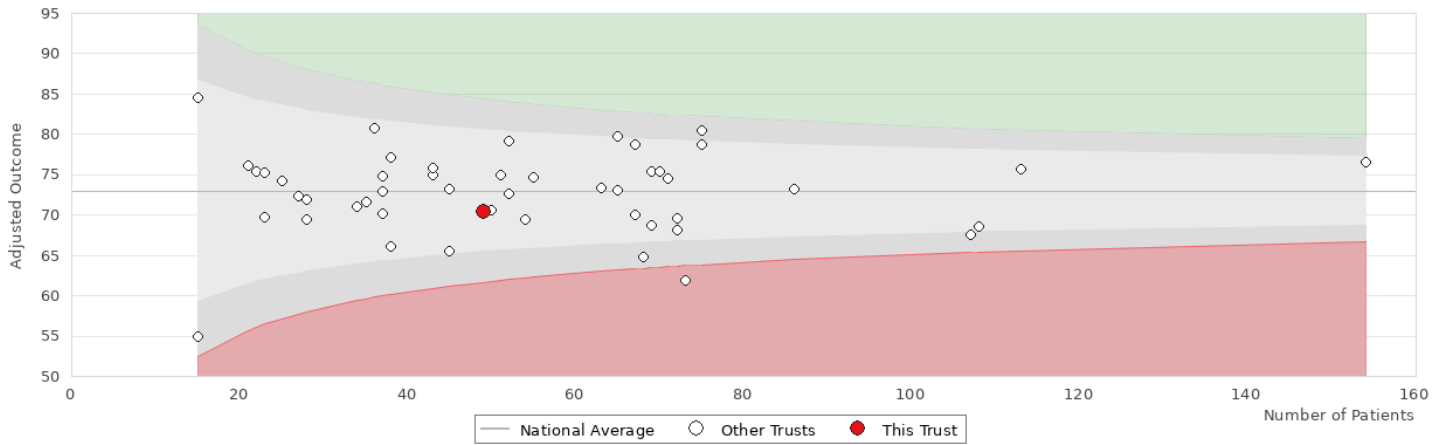

## Adjusted funnel plot for the mean sexual function score after radical prostatectomy by surgical centre in England and Wales.



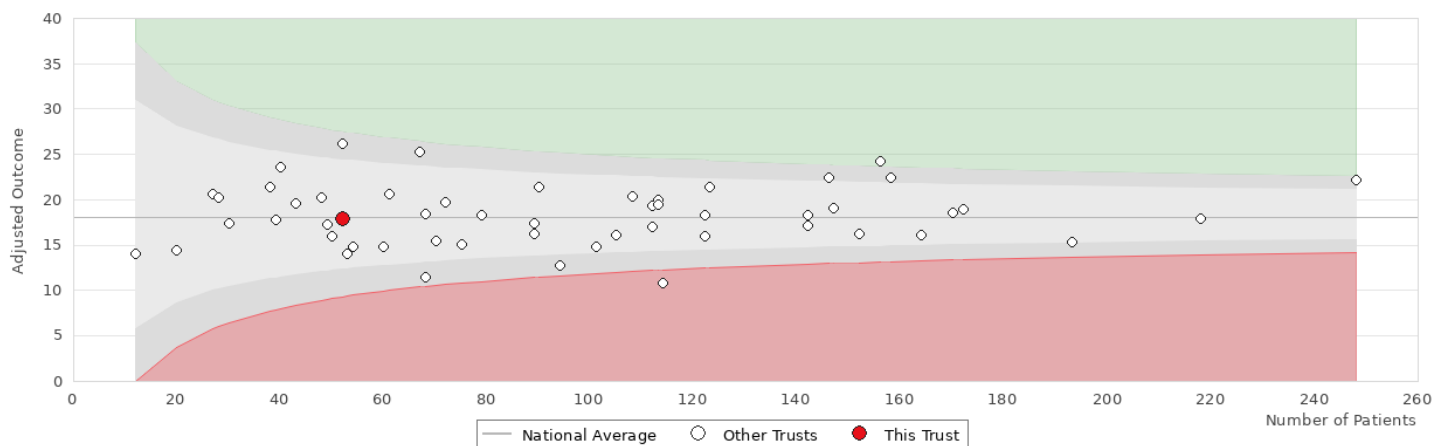

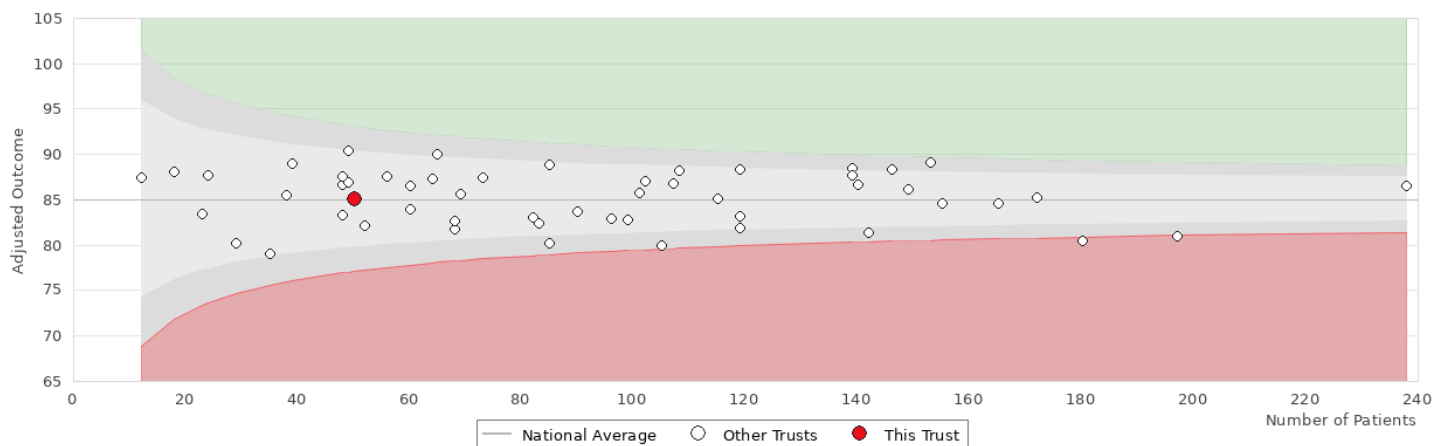
## Adjusted funnel plot for the mean sexual function score after radical radiotherapy by radiotherapy centre in England and Wales.
