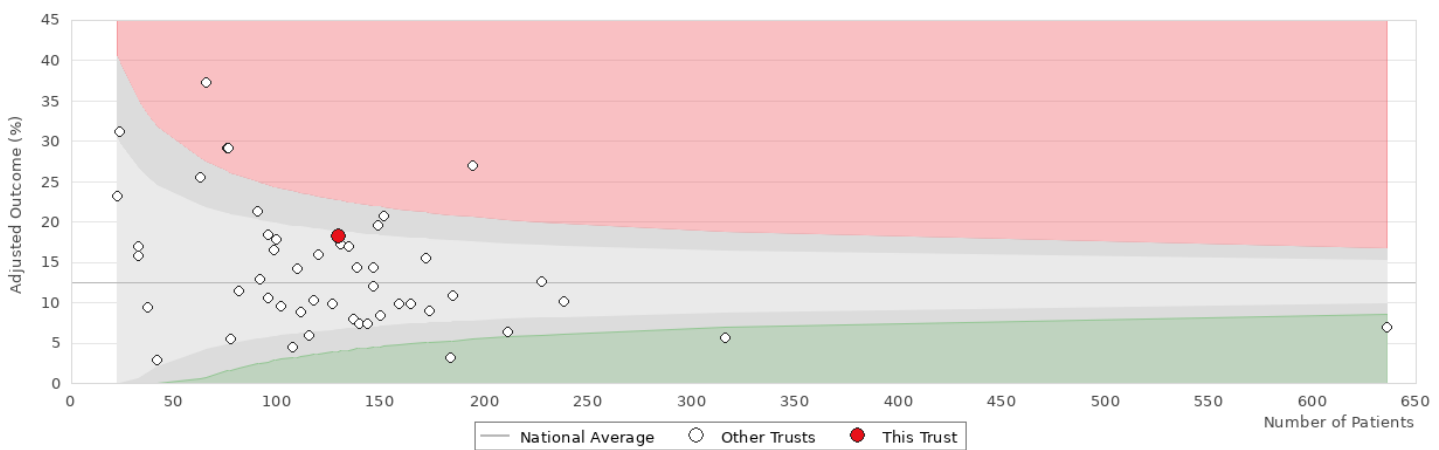

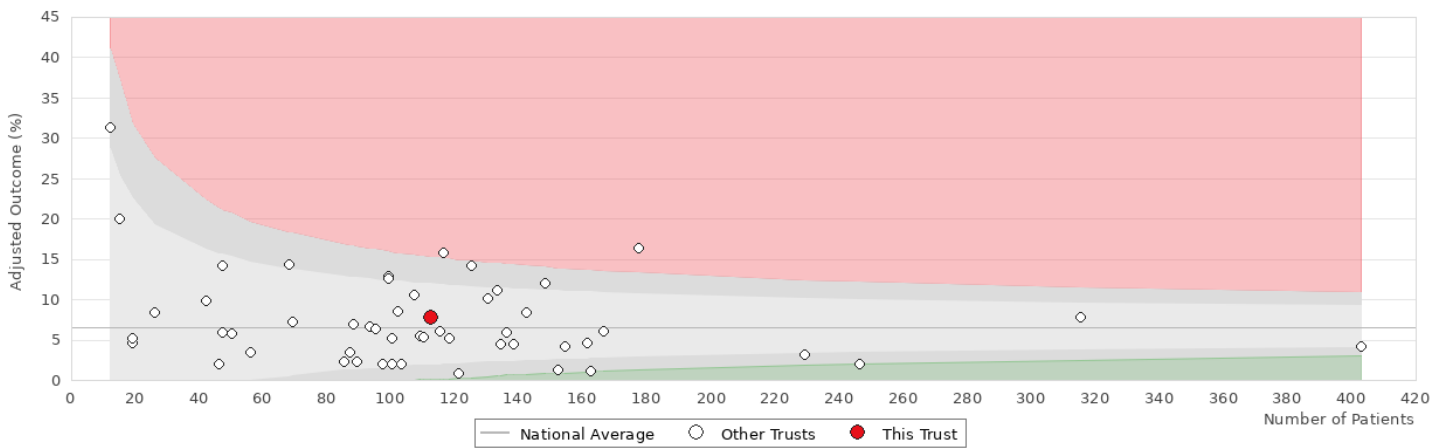

Adjusted funnel plot for the proportion of patients readmitted as an emergency within 90 days of radical prostatectomy by surgical centre in England and Wales.



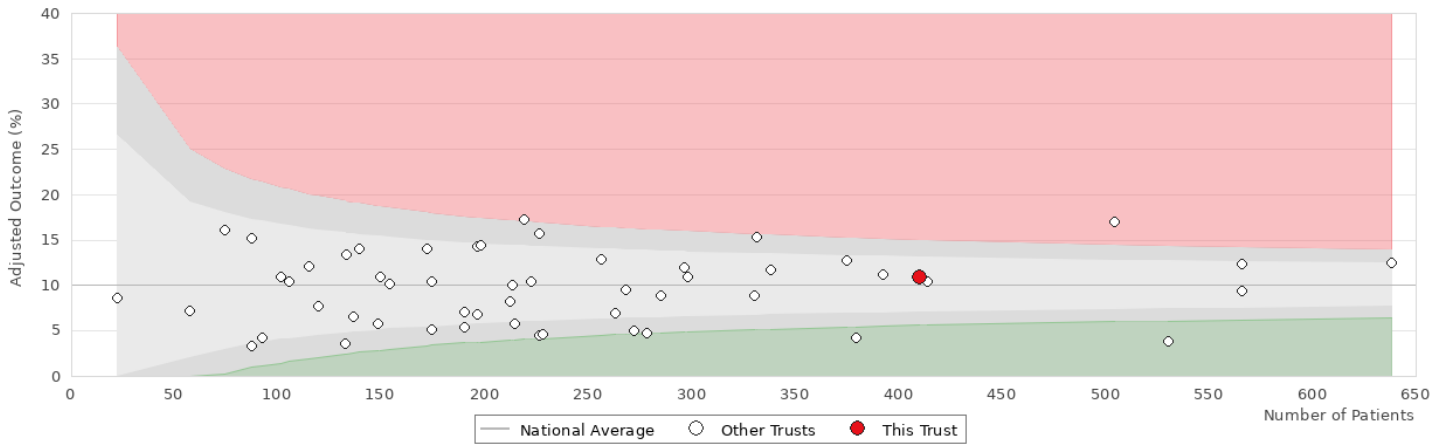
