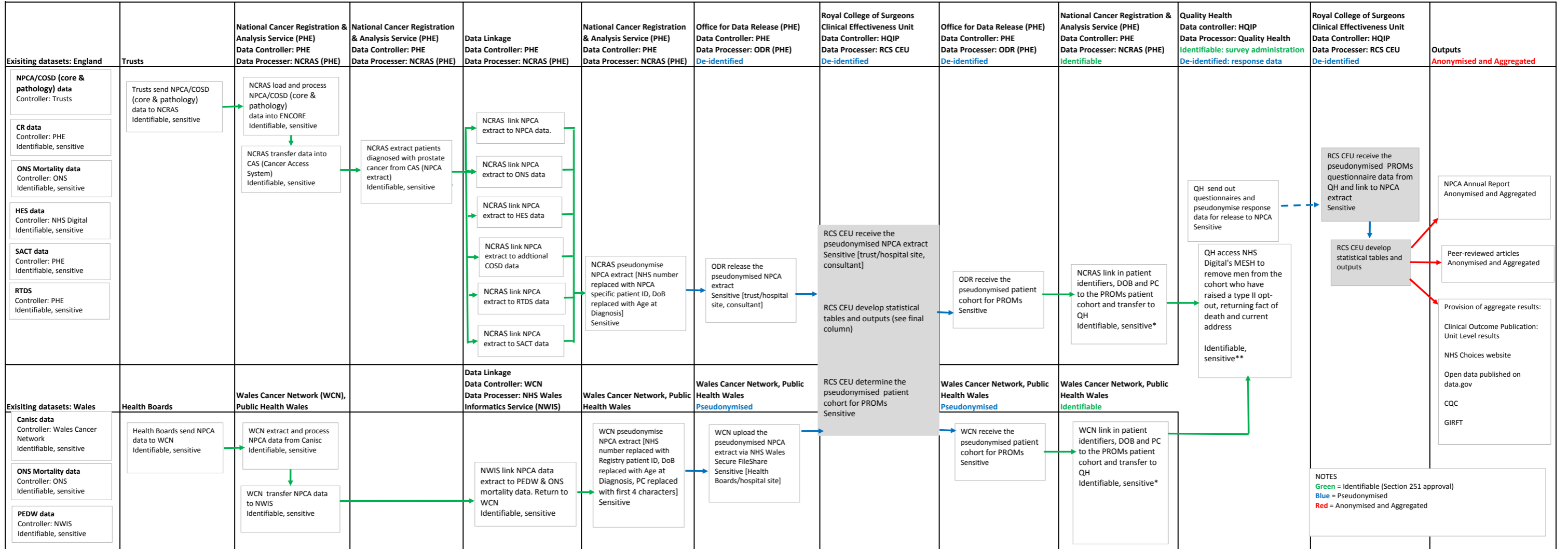

Support is required for processing of date of death only.

England: Following NHS Digital confirmation that processing of date of death is no longer classed as identifiable, but instead as 'sensitive' and can be released without the need for an exception to the common law duty of confidentiality, Public Health England have adopted the same approach. As a result, support under Regulation 5 is no longer required for processing of English data and exit from section 251 was England only was approved 20.10.20.

Wales: As the same approach has not been adopted by the NHS Wales Informatics Service (NWIS) to date support under Regulation 5 of the Health Service (Control of Patient Information) Regulations 2002 to confidential patient information without consent continues.
