The NPCA Annual Report 2022 was published on 12 January and is available for download on our website. The report covers men diagnosed or treated between 1 April 2020 and 31 March 2021 in England and Wales. It looks at whether the care these men received is consistent with recommended practice and provides information and resources to support healthcare providers, commissioners and regulators to improve care, including:

- Data guality and completeness
- Patient demographics
- Diagnosis, staging and treatment information
- Treatment outcomes
- Variation in treatment
- Impact of COVID-19


